Subject: Restricted area established in IJmuiden approaches

The director of the public body Central Nautical Management, also the State Harbour Master, announces the following:

Commencing June 9<sup>th</sup> 2006, due to the construction of the Offshore windpark near Egmond, an area restricted for shipping has been established in the approaches to IJmuiden. The area is enclosed by an imaginary line through the following cardinal buoys:

- South cardinal buoy "WM-S", character Q(6) + LFI 15s W in position  
52° 33.76 N 004° 26.81 E X = 91236 Y = 508753
- East cardinal buoy "WM-E", character Q(3) 10s W in position  
52° 36.19 N 004° 28.10 E X = 92751 Y = 513241
- North cardinal buoy "WM-N", character Q W in position  
52° 38.37 N 004° 25.09 E X = 89407 Y = 517328
- West cardinal buoy "WM-W", character Q(9) 15s W in position  
52° 37.87 N 004° 21.11 E X = 84903 Y = 516463
- West cardinal buoy "MM-W", character VQ(9) 10s W in position  
52° 36.38 N 004° 23.13 E X = 87144 Y = 513668

The relevant decree announcing the closure of this area for shipping has been published in the Staatscourant dated June 7<sup>th</sup> 2006.
