Subject: Update construction 2<sup>nd</sup> Coentunnel ( serial number CT-20/2009-7)

The director of the public body Central Nautical Management, also the State Harbour Master, announces the following:

Due to the construction of the separation dam to protect the existing Coentunnel during the construction of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Coentunnel, commencing Monday, June 7<sup>th</sup> 2010, a speed limit of 12 km/h and an overtaking ban will be enforced at the location of the build.

An exception will be made for the Connexxion Hydrofoils which due to their specific characteristics cause less bother at speed. These vessels will have to slow down when the available passage becomes to narrow to pass at speed.

In contradiction to the remark in Basijn 16/2010 stating that building of the separation dam would be finished in week 22, the expectation is now that work will last until the middle of September 2010.

A traffic regulation is in operation at the build location from the "Coentunnel 8". The Coentunnel 8 maintains a watch on VHF 68.
