Subject: Measures taken during Sail 2010

The director of the public body Central Nautical Management, also the State Harbour Master, announces the following:

Measures taken during Sail 2010

From Thursday, August 19th 2010 until Monday, August 23rd 2010 the event Sail 2010 will take place on the North Sea Canal and in the Eastern port area of Amsterdam. Due to this the following measures and obstructions will be taken and enforced.

1. Berths

During the event the berths in the IJ-haven, on the Sumatrakade, the Surinamekad, Noord between the IJplein and the Motorkanaal, the Zouthaven and the Eastern part of the De Ruijterkade are not available for use by regular shipping.

The water to the North of the Sumatrakade and Surinamekade up to the buoy line of the fairway will be designated as event area. This area is not accessible for the public during preannounced events. The event area will be marked by a yellow buoy line.

2. Obstructions

All obstructions will last as short as possible or as long as necessary.

3. Traffic measures

- a.** Due to the Sail in on Thursday August 19th 2010 from 09:00 hours until 17:00 hours a maximum sailing speed of 6 km/hr will be implemented in the North Sea Canal area.
- b.** During the entire event a maximum sailing speed of 6 km/hr will be implemented on the IJ between the Stenen Hoofd and the Eastern corner of the Surinamekade and the IJ-haven.
- c.** During the periods and on the locations mentioned in a. and b. of this Basijn it is forbidden:
- To propel a vessel exclusively by means of it's sails. A vessel under sail must use its mechanical propulsion at the same time. (the mandatory signals mentioned in the regulations must be carried).
 - To sail with sailing boards, jet skis, floating inflatable walk balls and similar floating objects.
 - To anchor on the North Sea Canal, the Afgesloten IJ including the free anchorage in the Eastern port area and the IJ-haven for as far as these berths are not reserved.
- d.** Before transiting the area mentioned under b. during the event Sail 2010 operational agreement must be reached before commencing the journey. For vessels leaving the Amsterdam-Rhine canal or the Oranje locks with a destination in the harbours to the West the agreements must be reached with Post Schellingwoude, (VHF 60). For vessels with destination Amsterdam-Rhine canal or Oranje locks agreement must be reached with traffic control of the Port of Amsterdam, (VHF 68).

4. CNB decree

The above mentioned measures will be formally announced in a CNB decree.

NB. If it is deemed necessary by the Harbour Master due to (local) situations, acute obstructions, adjustments to obstructions and generally enforced traffic measures can be announced.

Directions issued by or on behalf of the Harbour Master of Amsterdam must be followed promptly.
