Subject: Change of Port Admission Policy IJmuiden port

The director of the public body Central Nautical Management, also the State Harbour Master, announces the following:

The strongly increased shipping traffic in the region in combination with the supervision of more stringent safety rules and the existing policy to decrease the safety risks in the harbour as much as possible, is reason to readjust the port admission policy for the port of IJmuiden.

Due to the above mentioned it has been decided as from February 1st. 2002 port entrance in the IJmuiden outer harbour is only allowed for shipping bound for a berth in the Amsterdam-North Sea Canal area.
